Statement from OMB Director Mick Mulvaney:

**Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled
“Establishment of Presidential Advisory Commission on Election Integrity”**

This executive order establishes the Presidential Advisory Commission on Electoral Integrity. Implementing this executive order would have a *de minimis* impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include a review of ways to strengthen the integrity of elections in order to protect and preserve the principle of one person, one vote. Implementing this executive order would have a *de minimis* impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-fiscal year period beginning in fiscal year 2017. The agencies anticipated to be impacted by this executive order are the General Services Administration and the Executive Office of the President.
