Statement from Acting OMB Director Russ Vought:

**Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled
“Enforcing the Regulatory Reform Agenda”**

This executive order, among other things, requires certain executive departments and agencies to undertake steps to eliminate regulatory burdens on the American people, including, but not limited to, identifying for potential elimination any regulations that: eliminate jobs or inhibit job creation; are outdated, unnecessary, or ineffective; or impose costs that exceed benefits. Implementing this executive order would have a *de minimis* impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include alleviating unnecessary regulatory burdens placed on the American people. Implementing this executive order would have a *de minimis* impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-fiscal year period beginning in fiscal year 2017. The agencies anticipated to be impacted by this executive order include all executive departments and agencies, except those receiving waivers under Section 5 of the order.
