Statement from Acting OMB Director Russ Vought:

**Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled
“Revocation of Executive Order Creating Labor-Management Forums”**

This executive order revokes executive order 13522. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include the discontinuation of labor-management Forums that consumed considerable managerial time and were not fulfilling their goals. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-fiscal year period beginning in fiscal year 2017. The agencies anticipated to be impacted by this executive order include those departments and agencies with labor-management forums.
