Statement from Acting OMB Director Russ Vought:

**Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled
“President’s Council on Sports, Fitness, and Nutrition”**

This executive order revokes executive order 13545 and revises executive order 13265 by amending certain provisions. Implementing this executive order would have a *de minimis* impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include the development of a national strategy to increase youth sports participation, among other things. Implementing this executive order would have a *de minimis* impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-fiscal year period beginning in fiscal year 2018. The agency anticipated to be impacted by this executive order is the Department of Health and Human Services.
