Statement from Acting OMB Director Russ Vought:

**Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled  
“Providing for the Closing of Executive Departments and Agencies of the Federal  
Government on December 5, 2018”**

This executive order, among other things, directs that all executive departments and agencies of the Federal Government shall be closed on December 5, 2018, as a mark of respect for George Herbert Walker Bush, the forty-first President of the United States. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include paying respect to George Herbert Walker Bush, the forty-first President of the United States. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-fiscal year period beginning in fiscal year 2019. The agencies anticipated to be impacted by this executive order include all executive departments and agencies.
