Statement from Acting OMB Director Russ Vought:

**Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled  
“Providing for the Closing of Executive Departments and Agencies of the Federal  
Government on December 24, 2018”**

This executive order directs that all executive departments and agencies of the Federal Government shall be closed and their employees excused from duty on Monday, December 24, 2018, the day before Christmas Day, among other things. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include allowing Federal Government employees, where practicable, to spend December 24<sup>th</sup> with their families and loved ones. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-fiscal year period beginning in fiscal year 2019. The agencies anticipated to be impacted by this executive order include all executive departments and agencies.
