Statement from Acting OMB Director Russ Vought:

**Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled
“Advancing American Kidney Health”**

This executive order requires the Department of Health and Human Services to undertake certain actions to advance American kidney health. Implementing this executive order would have a *de minimis* impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include increasing patient choice through affordable alternative treatments for end-stage renal disease by encouraging higher value care, educating patients on treatment alternatives, and encouraging the development of artificial kidneys and increasing access to kidney transplants by modernizing the organ recovery and transplantation systems and updating outmoded and counterproductive regulations. Implementing this executive order would have a *de minimis* impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-fiscal year period beginning in fiscal year 2019. The agency anticipated to be impacted by this executive order is the Department of Health and Human Services.
