

## 16. FEDERAL DRUG CONTROL FUNDING

The 2022 Budget supports \$41.0 billion for National Drug Control Program agencies to implement the Biden Administration’s *Drug Policy Priorities for Year One*, including: expanding access to evidence-based treatment; advancing racial equity issues in our approach to drug policy; enhancing evidence-based harm reduction efforts; supporting evidence-based prevention efforts to

reduce youth substance use; reducing the supply of illicit substances; advancing recovery-ready workplaces and expanding the addiction workforce; and expanding access to recovery support services.

The funding requested by each Department and agency in the National Drug Control Program is included in the table below.
