Statement from Acting OMB Director Shalanda Young

Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled “The White House Initiative on Advancing Educational Equity, Excellence, and Economic Opportunity for Hispanics”

This executive order establishes the White House Initiative on Advancing Educational Equity, Excellence, and Economic Opportunity for Hispanics and the Presidential Advisory Commission on Advancing Educational Equity and Economic Opportunity for Hispanics. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include improved coordination of Federal policies, programs, and services to advance educational equity, excellence, and economic opportunity for Hispanic communities from cradle to career. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-year fiscal period beginning in fiscal year 2021. The agencies anticipated to be impacted by this executive order include the Department of Education.
