Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled "2022 Amendments to the Manual for Courts-Martial, United States"

This executive order updates the Manual for Courts-Martial. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include setting maximum sentencing guidelines for the crime of domestic violence in Article 128b, and implementing the addition of Article 117a, non-consensual distribution of intimate digital images, in to the Uniform Code of Military Justice. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-year fiscal period beginning in fiscal year 2022. The agency anticipated to be impacted by this executive order is the Department of Defense.
