Since President Biden signed the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law more than eight months ago, his Administration has hit the ground running to deliver investments that change people's lives for the better and get America moving again. Already, over \$110 billion has been announced and is headed to states, Tribes, territories, and local governments. In addition, there is billions more in funding available today through competitive programs.
