Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled "Advancing Economic Security for Military and Veteran Spouses, Caregivers, and Survivors"

This executive order seeks to reduce barriers to employment for military and veteran spouses, caregivers, and survivors, recognizing the importance of military-connected family economic well-being to the all-volunteer force. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include improving the ability of executive agencies to hire and retain military-connected spouses and increasing resources and support for military and veteran spouses, caregivers, and survivors in the workforce. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-year fiscal period beginning in fiscal year 2023. The agencies anticipated to be impacted by this executive order includes the Departments of State, Defense, Veterans Affairs, and Homeland Security, among others.
