Statement from OMB Director Shalanda Young

Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled "Federal Research and Development in Support of Domestic Manufacturing and United States Jobs"

This executive order would further the efforts of this Administration to build strong, resilient supply chains by encouraging the use of domestic manufacturing in the production of goods that rely upon cutting-edge technologies developed, in part, through federally funded research and development (R&D). Implementing this executive order would have no impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. This executive order would drive agencies' efforts to expand the production of new technologies in the United States and modernize reporting requirements to document where and by whom such technologies are utilized. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-year fiscal period beginning in fiscal year 2023. The agencies anticipated to be impacted by this executive order include the Departments of Defense, Agriculture, Commerce, Health and Human Services, Homeland Security, Energy, and Transportation, as well as the National Aeronautics and Space Administration and the National Science Foundation.
