Statement from OMB Director Shalanda Young

Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled “Scaling and Expanding the Use of Registered Apprenticeships in Industries and the Federal Government and Promoting Labor-Management Forums”

This executive order promotes and expands the use of registered apprenticeships throughout the Federal Government and will bring Labor Management Forums back to the Federal Government. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include broadening the pool of individuals who can access the benefits of Federal employment and increasing opportunities for worker voice. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-year fiscal period beginning in fiscal year 2024. The agencies anticipated to be impacted by this executive order include agencies across the Federal Government.
