Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled "Recognizing and Honoring Women's History"

This executive order would identify opportunities to improve recognition of women's history in Federal parks, lands, historic sites, and programs. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include directing the preparation of analyses and recommendations to strengthen the Federal Government's recognition of the role of women's history through increased representation of women at National Park Service sites and related sites. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-year fiscal period beginning in fiscal year 2024. The agencies anticipated to be impacted by this executive order includes the Department of the Interior.
