Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Executive Order 11845, as amended by Executive Order 12608, I am transmitting the cumulative report on rescissions. This report is required by section 1014(e) of the Congressional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974 (2 U.S.C. 685(e)). In accordance with the Act, the report is being transmitted concurrently to the Senate and will be published in the Federal Register.

This report provides the status of the 22 rescission proposals currently pending before the Congress and identified in the special message that was transmitted on June 3, 2025. That special message emphasized the need to cut wasteful foreign assistance spending at the Department of State as well as the Corporation for Public Broadcasting, the U.S. Agency for International Development, the U.S. Institute of Peace, and other International Assistance Programs. These rescissions would eliminate programs that are antithetical to American interests, politically biased, and an unnecessary expense to the American taxpayer.
