



# Invests in Rural America

*This landmark legislation modernizes the farm safety net, expands market access for farmers, and invests in rural economies. The One Big Beautiful Bill supports families, farmers, ranchers and delivers for rural America.*

**Modernizes the Farm Safety Net:** Updates outdated 2018 policies to protect farmers and ranchers from economic uncertainty, inflation, and volatile markets.

**Invests in American Agriculture:** Expands affordable crop insurance and improves risk management tools for livestock, aquaculture, honeybees, and specialty crops.

**Boosts Market Access:** Reduces trade barriers to help American farmers compete globally and sell more products abroad.

**Supports Family Farms:** Protects two million family farms from excessive taxation by raising the death tax exemption, helping generational farms stay in the family by increasing the amount family farms can inherit tax free.

**Combats Rising Costs:** Tackles the inflation and input cost crisis hurting small farms and rural economies.

**Rebuilds Local Economies:** Enhances the Opportunity Zone program to bring jobs and investment to rural and distressed communities.

**Defends Food Security:** Farm bankruptcies rose 55% in 2024—this bill protects producers and secures our food, fuel, and fiber supply chain.

**Reduces Foreign Dependence:** Strengthens American-made production and safeguards rural supply chains from global disruption. It helps American farmers, producers, and ranchers compete and sell products in foreign markets.

Invest in rural America and provide the certainty America's farm families need to continue operating and producing the affordable, safe, and abundant supply of food, fuel, and fiber that our nation relies on.

Expand market access and reduce global trade barriers.

Create certainty for producers across food, fuel, and fiber industries.

Support the next generation of farmers and ranchers with pro-growth, pro-farm family policies.

Unleash our economy, expand market access and deliver historic tax breaks to family farms.

# Commonsense Work Requirements

*The One Big Beautiful Bill restores the dignity of work with historically bipartisan work requirements for able-bodied Americans. We are implementing commonsense, Clinton-era work, volunteer, education, or training requirements. The One Big Beautiful Bill ensures able-bodied adults without dependents receiving welfare benefits are required to work, train, or volunteer at least 20 hours per week.*

**Ends Government Dependency Through Empowerment:** Welfare should be a short-term hand-up, not a lifetime handout—these commonsense work requirements will empower able-bodied Americans back into the workforce to take advantage of the strong job market President Trump is delivering.
