## **STATEMENT OF ADMINISTRATION POLICY**

**H.J. Res. 75 – Joint Resolution Providing for Congressional Disapproval  
of the Rule Submitted by the Department of Energy Relating to “Energy Conservation  
Program: Energy Conservation Standards for Commercial Refrigerators,  
Freezers, and Refrigerator-Freezers”**  
(Rep. Goldman, R-TX, and 13 cosponsors)

The Administration strongly supports passage of H.J. Res. 75, a joint resolution to disapprove the rule submitted by the Department of Energy relating to “Energy Conservation Program: Energy Conservation Standards for Commercial Refrigerators, Freezers, and Refrigerator-Freezers.”

The rule, implemented by the previous Administration, adopts amended energy conservation standards for commercial refrigerators, freezers, and refrigerator-freezers impacting large and small grocery stores and restaurants.

This rule represents yet another example of the previous Administration imposing undue burden on businesses and manufacturers through stringent energy conservation standards for refrigerators and freezers, while also limiting consumer choice for Americans.

If H.J. Res. 75 were presented to the President in its current form, his senior advisors would recommend that he sign it into law.
