STATEMENT OF ADMINISTRATION POLICY

H.R. 3668 – Improving Interagency Coordination for Pipeline Reviews Act

(Rep. Hudson, R-NC, and three cosponsors)

H.R. 3638 – Electric Supply Chain Act

(Rep. Latta, R-OH, and two cosponsors)

The Administration supports passage of H.R. 3668, the Improving Interagency Coordination for Pipeline Reviews Act, and H.R. 3638, the Electric Supply Chain Act. These bills support efforts to protect the reliability of our electric grid, promote American energy dominance, increase transparency and efficiency, and reduce government burdens. The Administration looks forward to working with Congress on a larger, comprehensive package that fixes our country's broken permitting system.

H.R. 3668 would streamline the permitting process of natural gas pipelines by strengthening the lead agency role of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, removing duplicative review requirements, and increasing communication between participating Federal and State agencies. The bill would reduce regulatory delay and help address the critical need to expand and modernize the nation's natural gas pipeline infrastructure.

H.R. 3638 would require the Department of Energy to conduct regular assessments and report to Congress on the supply chain for the generation and transmission of electricity. It would provide opportunities to conduct a wholesale assessment of the nation's electrical system, examine generation and transmission risks, evaluate national security considerations, and provide recommendations that would help secure supply chains and reduce vulnerability.

If H.R. 3668 and H.R. 3638 were presented to the President in their current form, his advisors would recommend that he sign them into law.
