STATEMENT OF ADMINISTRATION POLICY

H.R. 6938 – Commerce, Justice, Science; Energy and Water Development; Interior and Environment Appropriations Act, 2026

(Rep. Cole, R-OK)

The Administration supports H.R. 6938, which makes appropriations for Commerce, Justice, and Science and Related Agencies, Energy and Water Development and Related Agencies, Interior, Environment and Related Agencies for the fiscal year (FY) ending September 30, 2026.

The Administration is pleased that the Congress is advancing the appropriations process in a manner that avoids a bloated omnibus package and adheres to a fiscally responsible topline agreement that *decreases* overall discretionary spending. The measures included in this package contain no “poison pill” riders and fund critical Administration priorities at a rate that is \$2 billion below current levels, with significant reductions to non-defense spending.

Importantly, H.R. 6938 would ensure that the Administration continues to deliver on key aspects of President Trump’s agenda through FY 2026. The bill supports the Department of Justice’s successful efforts to reduce violent crime, root out fraud in Government programs, and address the past weaponization of the Department of Justice and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. H.R. 6938 would also support the Administration’s energy dominance agenda, while cutting funding for wasteful and unaligned programs.

The Administration urges every Member of Congress to support this fiscally responsible bill, which is a win for the American taxpayer, and looks forward to continuing to work with the Congress to pass additional appropriations bills to avoid another disastrous Government shutdown.

If this bill were presented to the President in its current form, his senior advisors would recommend that he sign it into law.
