Stay away from a three-block radius of any such person and where they live, work, or go to school.

Except  with a police escort to recover personal clothing, prescription medication, and toiletries

to facilitate parenting time/childcare, for which  contact through \_\_\_\_\_  written contact is permitted

as authorized by a later-issued order (which is in your possession) from Family Court or Juvenile Court.

- Do not use any alcohol, non-prescribed mood-altering drug, or illegal drug. Testing as Probation determines. Take any prescribed medication only as directed; provide a list of all prescribed medication to Probation and sign all necessary releases to allow Probation to confirm any prescription. If there is a positive test, a refusal to submit to testing, or tampering of any kind with the sample or the test, Probation may require you to enter treatment and/or complete a substance use disorder assessment with Probation as collateral and follow all recommendations.
- Complete a substance use disorder assessment with Probation Officer as collateral and follow all recommendations, including any further related evaluation, programming, counseling, or aftercare as directed by Probation.
- Restitution is:  granted in a separate order for \$ \_\_\_\_\_ or  reserved for \_\_\_\_\_ day(s).
  - The defendant agreed to pay restitution not to exceed \$ \_\_\_\_\_ or
  - A record was made regarding the defendant's income, resources, and obligations.

- Do not leave Minnesota unless you have the permission of your Probation Officer.
- Report to a law enforcement facility within the next 60 days to be fingerprinted.
- Do not use, possess, or transport any firearm, ammunition, or explosive.
- Follow all Probation Rules (see below).
  - Out of custody: go directly to Probation Intake (HCGC A-11/Brookdale/Ridgedale)
  - In custody or Remote: contact Probation Intake within 72 hours of your sentencing or release from custody (612-348-2110 or [POconnect@hennepin.us](mailto:POconnect@hennepin.us)).

**FINANCIAL ORDER**

Must be paid within six months.

- Pay:  Prosecution costs of \$ \_\_\_\_\_.

  - Any outstanding non-cash bond is discharged. Any previously forfeited bail or bond remains forfeited.
  - Any cash bail for which an Assignment of Bail has been filed is ordered refunded to the party indicated therein.
  - Cash bail (for which there is no Assignment of Bail) is:  fully refunded or  by your agreement, applied to any restitution, costs, surcharge, or fees, with any remaining bail to be refunded.

1. Follow all State and Federal criminal laws.
2. Contact your probation officer as directed.
3. Tell your Probation Officer within 72 hours if you have contact with law enforcement.
4. Tell your Probation Officer within 72 hours if you are charged with any new crime.
5. Tell your Probation Officer within 72 hours if you change your address, employment, or telephone number.
6. Cooperate with the search of your person, residence, vehicle, workplace, property, and things as directed by your probation officer.
7. Sign releases of information as directed.
