STATEMENT OF ADMINISTRATION POLICY

H.R. 4090 – Critical Mineral Dominance Act

(Rep. Stauber, R-MN, and two cosponsors)

The Administration supports passage of H.R. 4090, which would codify provisions of President Trump's Executive Order 14154, Unleashing American Energy, and Executive Order 14241, Immediate Measures to Increase American Mineral Production. The bill would strengthen domestic hardrock mineral development by improving transparency on the economic impacts of reliance on imported minerals, identify and expedite priority mining projects on Federal lands, and reduce unnecessary regulatory burdens to accelerate responsible mineral production critical to economic and national security.

Recognizing that mineral development is a national security priority, the Administration is committed to ensuring the United States is the leading producer and processor of critical minerals, including rare earth elements and metallurgical coal, in order to create jobs and prosperity at home, strengthen domestic supply chains, and reduce the global influence of adversarial states. Our nation's transportation, infrastructure, defense capabilities, and the next generation of technology rely upon a secure, predictable, and affordable supply of minerals. For these reasons, the Administration supports passage of H.R. 4090.

If this bill were presented to the President in its current form, his advisors would recommend that he sign it into law.
