**STATEMENT OF ADMINISTRATION POLICY**  
**House Amendment to S. 1383 – SAVE America Act**

The Administration strongly supports passage of the House Amendment to S. 1383, the Safeguard American Voter Eligibility (SAVE America) Act. This bill would enforce a principle long enshrined in our laws: only citizens of the United States may vote to choose the leaders of the United States. While Federal law explicitly prohibits foreign nationals from registering to vote or voting in Federal elections, loopholes and deficiencies in the National Voter Registration Act (NVRA) have allowed noncitizens to illegally register to vote and hindered States' ability to stop it.

Through amendments to the NVRA, the House Amendment to S. 1383 would end the lawlessness by requiring States to obtain proof of United States citizenship before registering an individual to vote in Federal elections, while establishing safeguards to ensure every citizen is able to register and vote with minimal burden. The bill would also require citizens to present identification upon voting and require States to regularly remove noncitizens from their existing voter rolls, providing them with the tools necessary to properly do so. Even more fundamental than enforcement of Federal law, the bill would increase the public's confidence in the fairness of our elections and the validity of their results.

If the House Amendment to S. 1383 were presented to the President in its current form, his advisors would recommend that he sign it into law.
