STATEMENT OF ADMINISTRATION POLICY

H.R. 5103 – Make the District of Columbia Safe and Beautiful Act of 2026

(Rep. McGuire, R-VA, and four cosponsors)

The Administration strongly supports passage of H.R. 5103, the Make the District of Columbia Safe and Beautiful Act of 2026, which aligns with President Trump’s Executive Order 14252, “Making the District of Columbia Safe and Beautiful.” H.R. 5103 would codify the principles of E.O. 14252 by authorizing a program to beautify the District of Columbia and establishing the District of Columbia Safe and Beautiful Commission. This bill also advances the Administration’s efforts to beautify the city and ensure it is prepared to appropriately receive visitors for America’s 250th. Together, the bill and the executive order advance a shared goal championed by President Trump: ensuring that the Nation’s Capital is clean, safe, and beautiful.

These reforms respond to rising crime in recent years under President Biden’s radical left-wing policies that have limited effective law enforcement and contributed to deteriorating conditions across the District. Prior to President Trump’s leadership, Washington, D.C., had one of the highest murder rates in the country; today, it has one of the lowest, reflecting the impact of his decisive action to restore law and order. By aligning responsibilities, improving coordination, and enabling long-term planning, the bill strengthens stewardship of the Nation’s Capital while supporting law enforcement and restoring public confidence.

If this bill were presented to the President in its current form, his advisors would recommend that he sign it into law.
