## **STATEMENT OF ADMINISTRATION POLICY**

**H.R. 5625 – Cashless Bail Reporting Act**  
(Rep. Harris, R-NC, and 23 cosponsors)

The Administration strongly supports H.R. 5625, the Cashless Bail Reporting Act. President Trump recognized the importance of not releasing from incarceration individuals whose pending criminal charges or criminal history demonstrate a clear ongoing risk to society in Executive Order 14342, Taking Steps to End Cashless Bail to Protect Americans. The Administration embraces commonsense policies that protect Americans' safety and well-being by identifying jurisdictions that needlessly release into the public individuals who are known threats.

If H.R. 5625 were presented to the President in its current form, his advisors would recommend that he sign it into law.
