## **STATEMENT OF ADMINISTRATION POLICY**

### **H.R. 6260 – Keeping Violent Offenders Off Our Streets Act**

(Rep. Fitzgerald, R-WI, and five cosponsors)

The Administration strongly supports H.R. 6260, the Keeping Violent Offenders Off Our Streets Act. Subjecting bail bonds to insurance fraud laws will allow States to enact licensing requirements for entities that post bail on behalf of defendants. This commonsense protection will reduce fraud and prevent recidivist offenders from causing further havoc in American communities. President Trump recognized the importance of a functional cash bail system in Executive Order 14342, Taking Steps to End Cashless Bail to Protect Americans. The Administration welcomes further efforts to protect the use of well-administered cash bail.

If H.R. 6260 were presented to the President in its current form, his advisors would recommend that he sign it into law.
