## **STATEMENT OF ADMINISTRATION POLICY**

### **H.R. 8365 – Monitor Accountability Act** (Rep. Biggs, R-AZ, and two cosponsors)

The Administration supports H.R. 8365, the Monitor Accountability Act. For years, activists have abused consent decrees and their attendant monitors to drive radical changes in State and local agencies, including our great law enforcement agencies. The American system of federalism and representative government should not allow for unelected monitors to endlessly superintend law enforcement and other government entities. Term limits, transparency, oversight, and public input for Federal monitors will restore democratic control to the American people.

If H.R. 8365 were presented to the President in its current form, his advisors would recommend that he sign it into law.
