STATEMENT OF ADMINISTRATION POLICY

S. 2 - Secure America Act

(Senator Graham, R-SC)

The Administration strongly supports immediate passage of S. 2, the Secure America Act.

Congressional Democrats have abdicated their responsibility to fully fund the Government, opting instead to withhold funding from Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) and Border Patrol in an attempt to protect violent criminal illegal aliens and undermine President Trump's highly successful border security agenda. The Trump Administration and congressional Republicans stand united in their refusal to acquiesce to Democrat intransigence, which means Republicans must use S. 2 to fund ICE and Border Patrol's base operations. Anything less would be an abdication of our responsibility to stand with the brave law enforcement officers who work to keep America safe and our borders secure.

S. 2 provides \$38 billion to ICE and \$26 billion to Border Patrol to fully fund these critical Department of Homeland Security (DHS) components through Fiscal Year (FY) 2029. Providing this funding through the end of President Trump's term ensures congressional Democrats are unable to hold paychecks for the brave men and women of ICE and Border Patrol hostage to their radical demands. The bill also provides a total of \$5 billion in additional appropriations to DHS to account for any unforeseen costs that ICE and Border Patrol may incur in future years as it carries out its mission to keep the American people safe.

The Secure America Act promotes the safety and security of the American people by providing needed funding to ICE and Border Patrol. President Trump expects the Congress to pass this legislation immediately.

If S. 2 were presented to the President in its current form, his senior advisors would recommend that he sign it into law.
