STATEMENT OF ADMINISTRATION POLICY

H.Con.Res. 113 - Establishing the congressional budget for the United States Government for fiscal year 2027 and setting forth the appropriate budgetary levels for fiscal years 2028 through 2036.

(Rep. Arrington, R-TX)

The Administration strongly supports the immediate passage of the resolution entitled “Concurrent resolution establishing the congressional budget for the United States Government for fiscal year 2027 and setting forth the appropriate budgetary levels for fiscal years 2028 through 2036.”

This budget resolution is a crucial first step in allowing congressional Republicans to quickly pass a budget reconciliation bill that protects America’s elections, strengthens America’s national defense, and supports American farmers.

For too long, congressional Democrats have obstructed efforts to restore confidence in American elections. This budget resolution begins the process to enable the Congress to enact critical election integrity measures included in the desperately-needed SAVE America Act on a party-line basis via the budget reconciliation process. The SAVE America Act includes commonsense measures to ensure only U.S. citizens are registered to vote in Federal elections and require the use of voter ID, which are critical for election integrity.

The reconciliation bill made possible by this budget resolution would also provide funding necessary for the Department of War (DOW) to cover increased operational costs and readiness expenses, while making investments to support critical capabilities, munitions procurement, and strengthen the U.S. industrial base. The reconciliation bill would also help lower food prices by providing much-needed economic assistance to America’s farmers.

The Administration is committed to working closely with the Congress to pass another budget reconciliation bill as soon as possible to secure the Nation’s elections and provide critical funding to DOW and America’s farmers. To do so, the House of Representatives must pass this budget resolution—without modification—immediately.

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
