STATEMENT OF ADMINISTRATION POLICY

Senate Amendment to H.R. 5334 – Lindsey O. Graham Sanctioning Russia and Iran Act of 2026

(Sen. Graham, R-SC, and 62 cosponsors)

The Administration supports passage of the Senate Amendment to H.R. 5334, the Lindsey O. Graham Sanctioning Russia and Iran Act. This bill would, among other provisions, mandate the imposition of sanctions on Russian officials, financial institutions, and other persons related to the Government of the Russian Federation.

The bill supports President Trump's efforts to achieve peace in the Russia-Ukraine war by strengthening the authorities he can use to encourage Russia to accept terms for peace. The scope of the bill significantly increases measures to encourage Russia to make progress toward a negotiated resolution of the war and increases costs for those who are still doing business with Russian entities. The bill also includes key provisions that will incentivize a resolution to the war, including allowing full Presidential discretion on waivers and an authority for the President to terminate sanctions after a peace agreement is reached.

The Administration also supports the inclusion of key provisions to extend the Iran Sanctions Act of 1996 for five years. These provisions ensure President Trump maintains critical authorities to prevent Iran from promoting terrorism or attaining its nuclear ambitions.

For these reasons, if the Senate Amendment to H.R. 5334 were presented to the President in its current form, his advisors would recommend he sign it into law.
